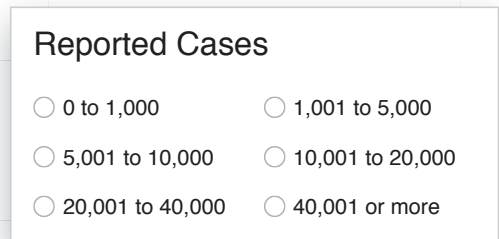
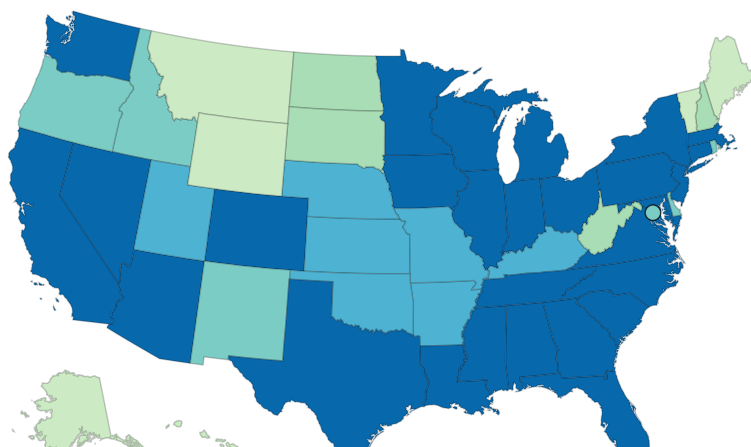

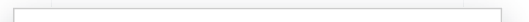

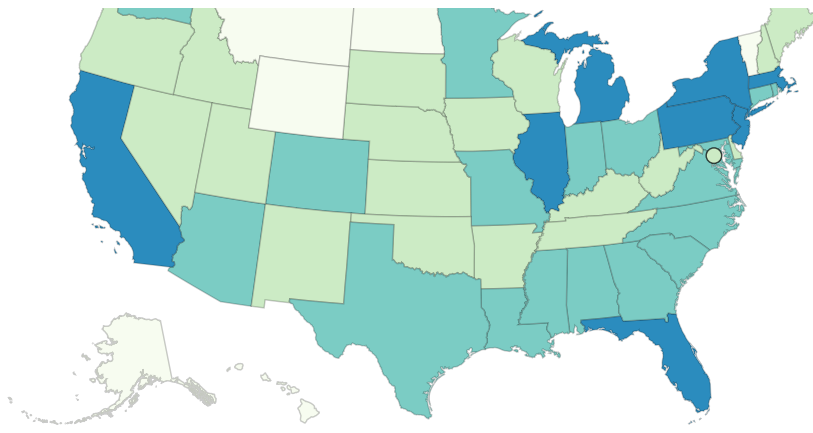

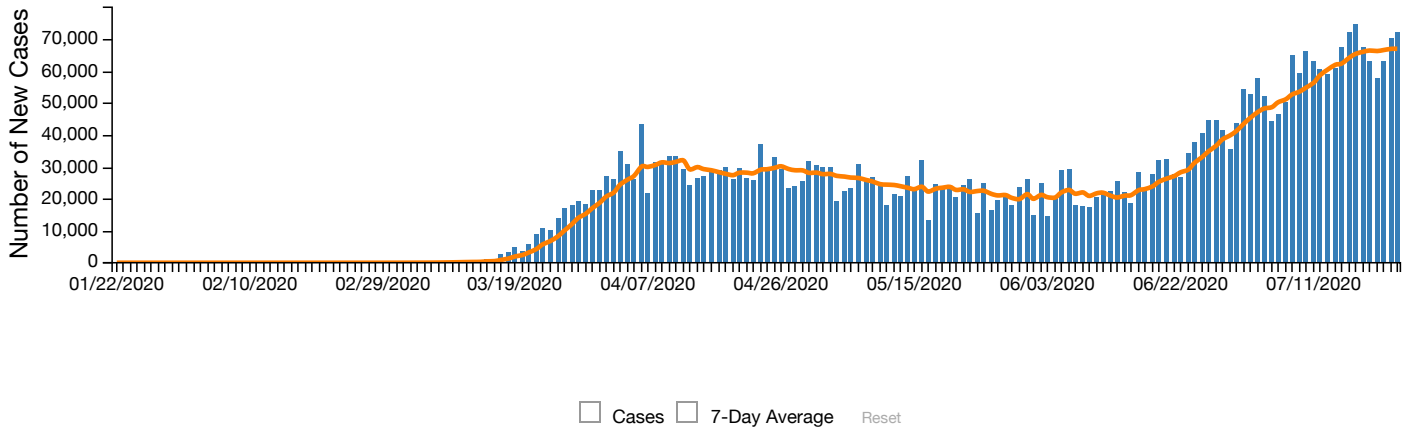

Cases & Deaths among Healthcare Personnel

Data were collected from 3,075,235 people, but healthcare personnel status was only available for 657,354 (21.4%) people. For the 109,602 cases of COVID-19 among healthcare personnel, death status was only available for 74,028 (67.5%).
