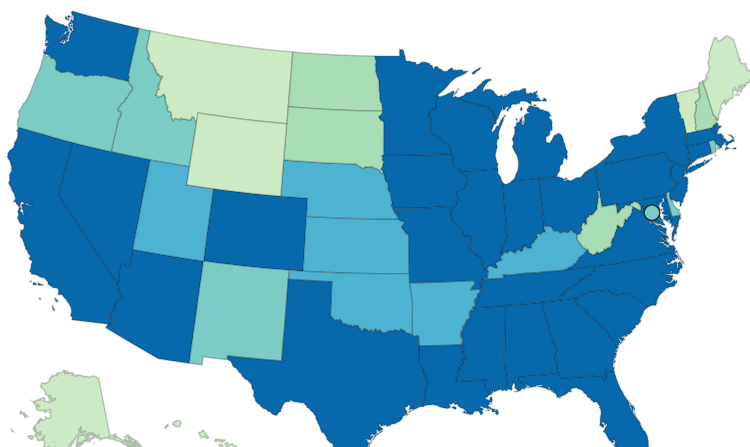

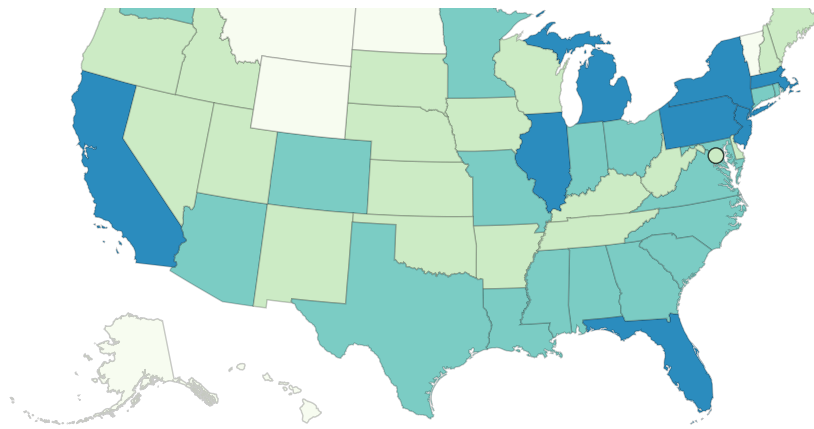

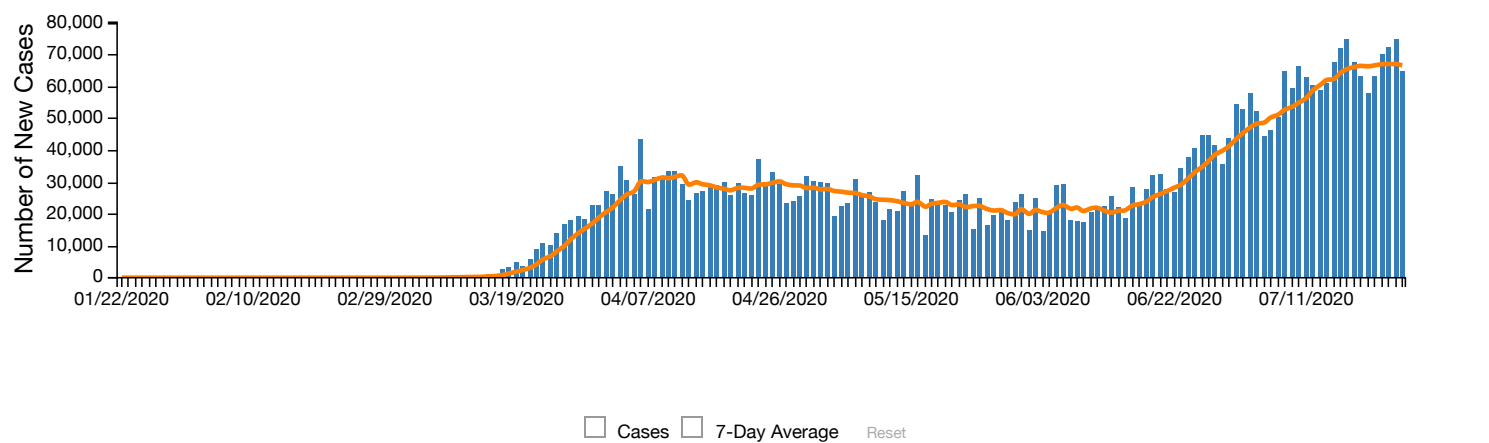

Cases & Deaths among Healthcare Personnel

Data were collected from 3,186,778 people, but healthcare personnel status was only available for 688,271 (21.6%) people. For the 113,731 cases of COVID-19 among healthcare personnel, death status was only available for 76,253 (67.0%).
