









Cases & Deaths among Healthcare Personnel

Data were collected from 3,752,800 people, but healthcare personnel status was only available for 828,996 (22.1%) people. For the 128,933 cases of COVID-19 among healthcare personnel, death status was only available for 88,622 (68.7%).
