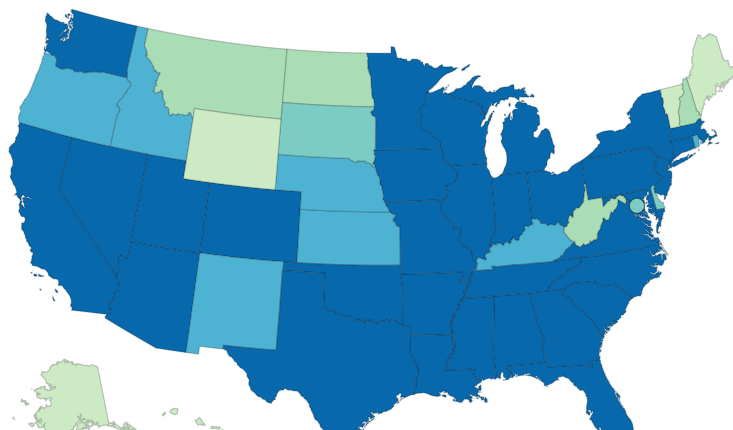

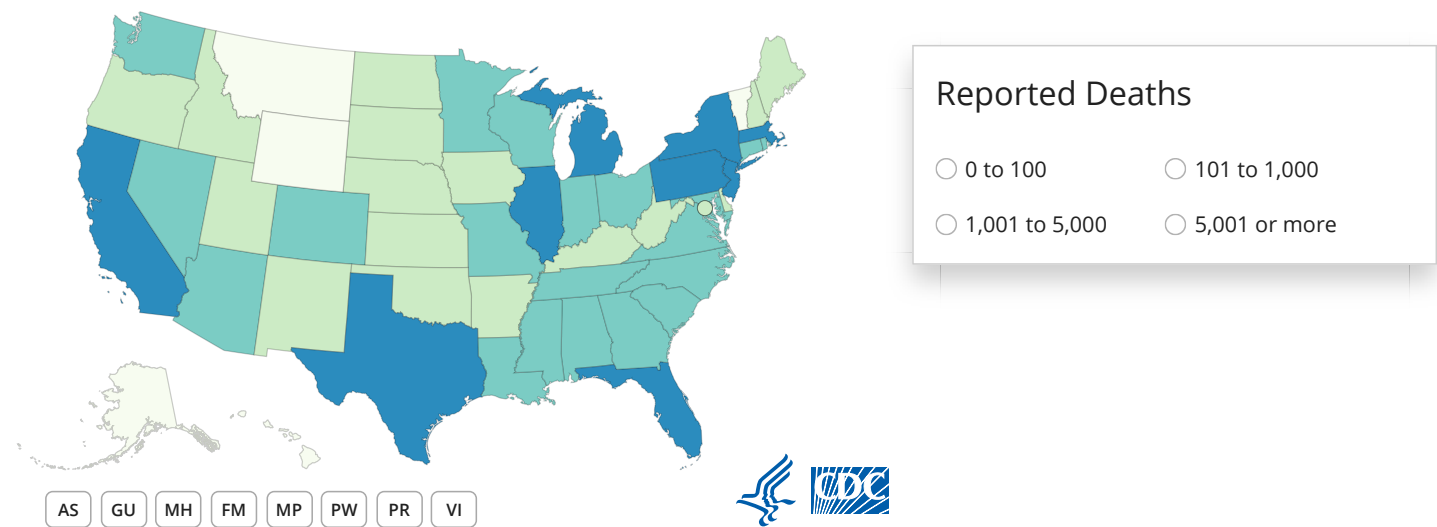

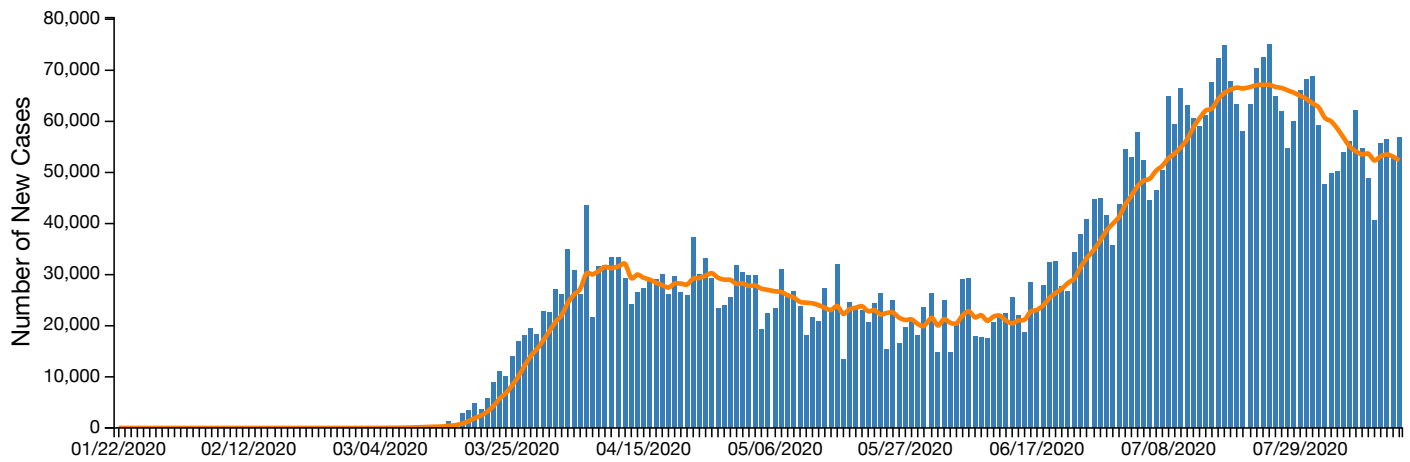

Data were collected from 3,924,574 people, but healthcare personnel status was only available for 879,436 (22.4%) people. For the 134,397 cases of COVID-19 among healthcare personnel, death status was only available for 93,236 (69.4%).
