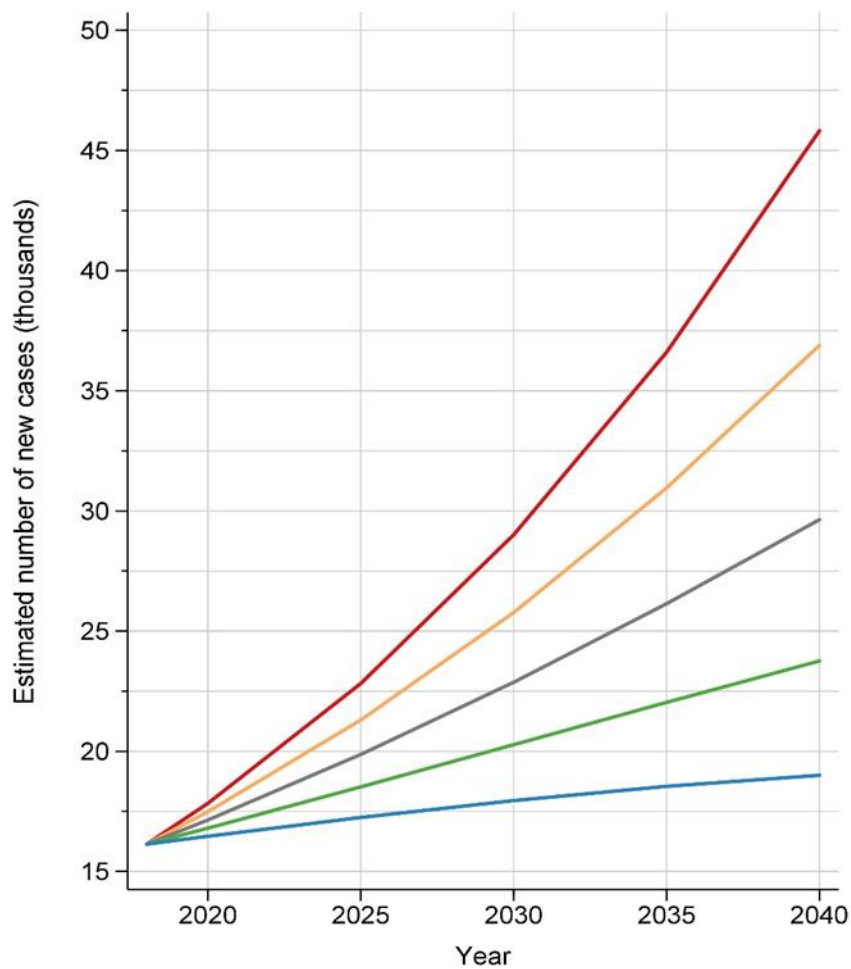

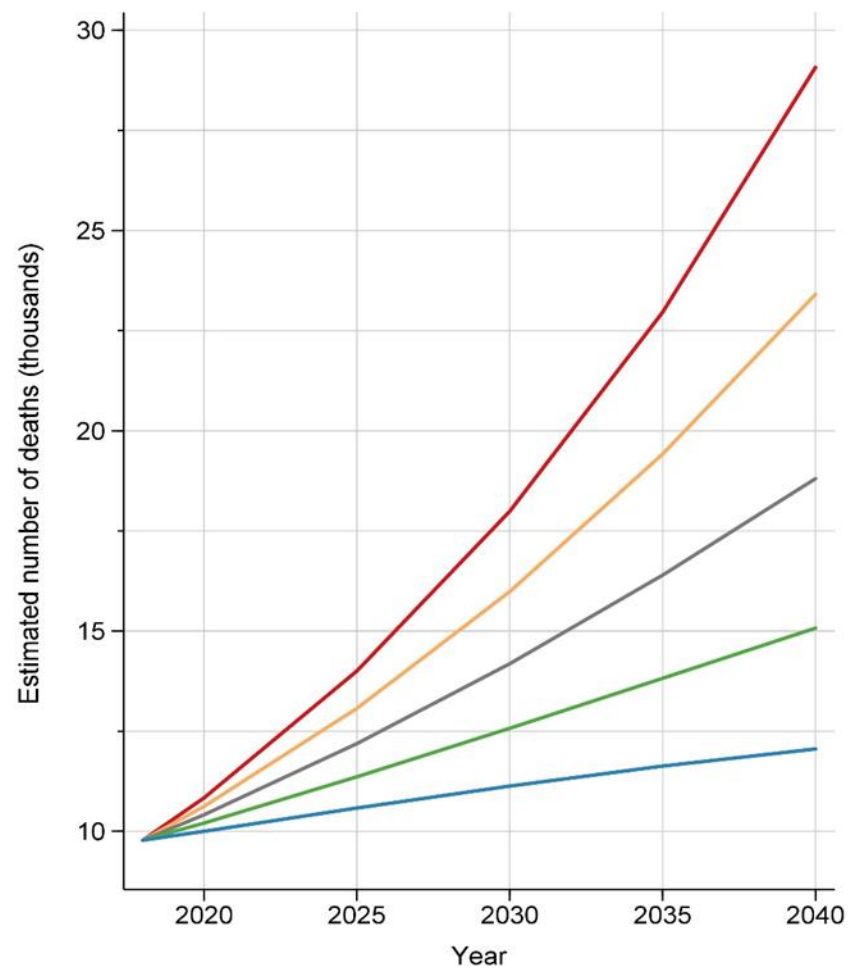


Assuming global increase of — +2% — +1%
