

Disclaimer: The data represent viral COVID-19 laboratory test (reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction) results from laboratories in the United States, including commercial and reference laboratories, public health laboratories, hospital laboratories, and other testing locations. The data represent laboratory test totals—not individual people—and exclude antibody and antigen tests. The data are subject to delayed several days in order to mitigate discrepancies in daily test counts due to variation in jurisdiction reporting. The data may also not include results from all testing sites within a jurisdiction (e.g., point-of-care test sites) and therefore reflect the majority, but not all, COVID-19 tests in the United States.

The data are reported to state and jurisdictional health departments in accordance with applicable state or local law and in accordance with the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (CARES Act Section 18115). The data for each state are sourced from data submitted directly by the state health department via COVID-19 electronic laboratory reporting (CELRS), or a combination of commercial, public health, and in-house hospital laboratories. CELRS data are used for states that either submit line-level data or submit aggregate counts that do not include antigen or antibody tests.
